

Invitation to Pilots of Vintage Aircraft:

Heidelberg Great Train Race: Saturday 30 September 2023

Dear Vintage Aircraft Pilot:

It gives me great pleasure to invite you to the 2023 Heidelberg Great Train race. Many thanks in particular to **Reinhardt Transport** for their valuable sponsorship.

Herewith the itinerary, from the pilot's point of view:

- 1. The ROVOS RAIL vintage steam locomotive/s will arrive at the Heidelberg Station at **09h00**. Biplanes in the skies at that time would be appreciated.
- 2. The extraordinary 1930 Gurney Nutting Bentley (see below) will "pair" with the locomotive (or locomotives) at very low speed along the station platform.
- 3. The Bentley and the loco/s will stop at the end of the platform alongside the for photographs with the ROVOS passengers (dressed in vintage regalia) and aircraft in the sky.
- 4. The "pic of the day" (Locos, Bentley, and Biplane, in a single image), will be used to create water colour painting, with limited number of prints to be made available at a black tie function some time in 2024.
- 5. The Bentley will then depart from the station platform and conduct a short tour through Heidelberg, then proceed to the Heidelberg Airfield.
- 6. The (numbered) vintage cars and motorcycle participants will follow the Bentley's route past the locomotives and on to the Airfield.
- 7. At the Airfield the Bentley and the vintage cars and motorcycles will thread their way through the parked vintage aircraft for photographs.
- 8. Pilots are encouraged to be attired in **period correct flying gear** and pose next to their aircraft for these pics.
- 9. After the event, a website *HeidelbergGreatTrainRace2023Images* will be constructed that will contain the images taken on the 30th of September 2023 for purchase from the photographer.
- 10. From 07h30, pilots will be provided with a **free Breakfast Roll**. World class coffee (supplied by The Grind) will be on sale (vs. a free cup of brutal coffee).

Vintage Motorcycle Racing

For the first time in South Africa, pucker vintage flat-track motorcycle race will be held. Competing motorcycles will be solid-frame units built before the war. Headed by an original **1922 Brecia Bugatti** pace car, the race will take place in two heats at the Heidelberg Airfield. A sight not to be missed. For safety reasons the track will be fenced off from the public.

World War II Aircraft Engine

To be fired up at the airfield:

1941 ROLLS-ROYCE GRIFFON V12 engine.

Designed in 1938, the Rolls-Royce Griffon is a British 37-litre 60-degree V12 liquid cooled engine producing 1290kW at altitude 750ft and 1110kW at 14000 ft. It has a single-stage two-speed supercharger. A sight and sound to behold.
